Rushmere Vase Conditions

The competition is open to any amateur (handicap 12 or less) who is a full member of any Club affiliated to Suffolk County Golf Union. Entries will only be accepted on the above form, which should be detached and sent to the General Manager, Rushmere Golf Club. The Competition will consist of 36 holes medal play, played under handicap. The competitor returning the best net score for the 36 holes will win the Rushmere Vase.

As a minimum, there will be prizes for 1st, 2nd For the Rushmere Vase (Net), 1st, 2nd, (Gross). There will also be prizes for 1st places in both the morning and afternoon rounds and for the best Scratch Score and Net score. **Ties will be decided on the best second round or the last 9 holes (10 to 18 on the card).** If the entry is over-subscribed, there will be a ballot. Places will be allotted in proportion to the number of applications received in each of the Categories 1 and 2.

Any dispute must be referred to the Committee in writing. The decision of the Committee will be final. The Committee also reserves the right to refuse any entry and to make such alterations to the conditions as considered necessary.

<u>Note:</u> This is a qualifying competition and, in entering, all players acknowledge themselves bound to report their scores to their Home Club.
